Do you support or oppose...

ABORTION REGULATION: Requiring parental consent before a minor child's abortion, notwithstanding previous judicial concerns?

NO RESPONSE

Optional Candidate Comment: *Depends on the child's situation. Are they an emancipated minor? Are they abused by their parents? Are they 17 and already nearly an adult?*

ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE: Increasing access to care for uninsured Floridians, especially the working poor?

SUPPORT

Optional Candidate Comment: *Gov. Scott's turning down of a federal expansion of Medicaid left millions of Floridians without health care coverage.*

AFFORDABLE HOUSING: Using all state housing trust funds as intended to address affordable housing needs in Florida?

SUPPORT

Optional Candidate Comment: *Affordable housing is one of the biggest issues we face in Florida, especially Tampa and Hillsborough County.*

DEATH PENALTY REPEAL: Ending Florida's use of the death penalty while preserving the alternative of a life sentence without parole?

SUPPORT

END-OF-LIFE PROTECTION: Preserving Florida law that bans physician-assisted suicide?

OPPOSE

Optional Candidate Comment: *I think public opinion on this is already shifting and the future will hold an even bigger shift into acceptance of doctor-assisted suicide.*

FREEDOM TO SERVE: Allowing individuals and organizations the freedom to serve the public in accord with reasoned conscientious beliefs related to sexuality and marriage?

SUPPORT

Optional Candidate Comment: *As long as they are not attempting to project those beliefs onto the public they intend to serve.*

IMMIGRATION: Urging Congress to undertake extensive immigration reform, rather than adopting piecemeal state policies?

NO RESPONSE

Optional Candidate Comment: *Turning away people seeking asylum and separating families at the border is not what this country is about. Something needs to be done to address immigration but not turning away asylum seekers or separating families.*

JUVENILE JUSTICE: Establishing that children under 14 shall not be transferred to the adult criminal justice system?

SUPPORT

PARENTAL EMPOWERMENT: Creating education savings accounts to use for nonpublic school tuition?

NO RESPONSE

Optional Candidate Comment: *Skeptical about this question. Where does the money come from? Who holds it? Is it state funded?*

SAFETY OF SCHOOLCHILDREN: Expanding existing legislative initiatives to harden the physical security of nonpublic schools?

OPPOSE

Optional Candidate Comment: *The legislature already put an unfunded mandate on public schools. It's obvious there is not enough money to fund the public school projects, I cannot imagine that there is money to offer to nonpublic schools.*
