ABORTION LIMITS: Prohibiting abortion when a fetus has reached 20 weeks gestation and has the capacity to feel pain? <i>Optional Comments: I would support exceptions if the mother's health is gravely endangered.</i>	SUPPORT
ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE: Increasing health coverage options for uninsured Floridians, especially the unemployed and the working poor? <i>Optional Comments: I support a one-payer health program.</i>	SUPPORT
AFFORDABLE HOUSING: Using all state housing trust funds as intended to address affordable housing needs in Florida?	SUPPORT
CRIMINAL JUSTICE: Authorizing courts to impose a sentence less than the mandatory minimum term of imprisonment for nonviolent crimes? <i>Optional Comments: I do not support mandatory sentencing. Judges must be able to "judge" each situation on an individual basis.</i>	SUPPORT
DEATH PENALTY REPEAL: Ending Florida's use of the death penalty while preserving the alternative of a life sentence without parole?	SUPPORT
END-OF-LIFE PROTECTION: Preserving Florida law that bans doctor-prescribed suicide?	OPPOSE
FREEDOM TO SERVE: Allowing health care providers and workers the freedom to serve in accord with their conscience?	NO RESPONSE
PARENTAL EMPOWERMENT: Eliminating the requirement to attend public school the year prior to receiving a state scholarship for K-12 non-public schools? <i>Optional Comments: I oppose state money supporting K-12 non-public schools.</i>	OPPOSE
PROTECTING WORKERS: Requiring drinking water, shade, and annual heat illness training be provided for farmworkers and other outdoor workers?	SUPPORT
RELIGIOUS FREEDOM: Respecting the autonomy of non-public schools to maintain policies that distinguish dress codes and other aspects of student life on the biological basis of sex? <i>Optional Comments: I do not support the matter of gender dress codes in public schools, but respect the rights of private institutions who do not receive public funding to set their dress codes.</i>	SUPPORT
